Join us for mad Lego building around a different theme each month. Display what you've made at the library.

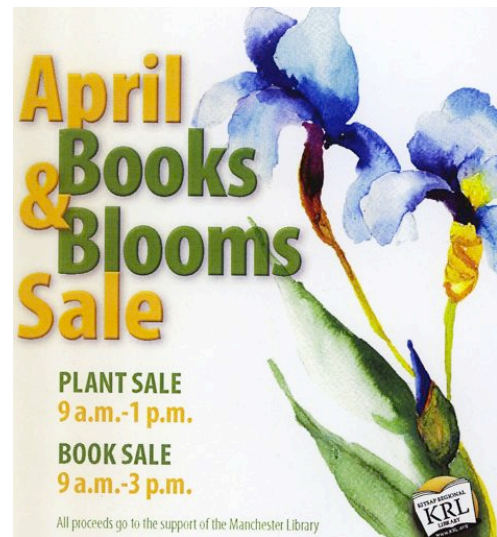

Dear Patrons and Friends of the Manchester Library,

In cooperation with the Kitsap Foundation, the Friends of the Manchester Library are participating in a Day of Giving on **Tuesday May 6, 2014**. This is part of a nationwide day of giving which is carried out on-line. The Kitsap Foundation has lined-up a number of charitable organizations which will partially match any funds we can get donated on-line that day. On that day, we can receive a match to your donation that will likely be on the order of 30-50%!!! There is a minimum donation of \$10 and you pay for it via a secure credit card donation on-line.

The Kitsap Foundation has already lined-up matching donations to the tune of \$110,000 which will be distributed to the approximately 200 non-profits who are participating. Matching funds for each participating non-profit will be in proportion to the funds raised.
