NEW ROOF Fund Drive !!

The Manchester Library roof is showing signs of its age! Recently we have had a few leaks and now The Friends of the Library believe is the time to replace the roofing. As you probably know, the Friends of the Library actually own the Manchester Library building and are responsible for maintaining the library...and the roof!!!

We are asking all our library patrons and those who appreciate having the library as a community resource to help us fund the new roof. Our target for this fundraiser is \$7,000.00. If you can spare a few dollars, we can make this happen! There is a "new roof" donation box on the circulation desk of the Library.

The "Friends" are also submitting a grant request to the Birkenfeld Trust to allow us to add solar energy panels to provide up to 90% of our electrical needs throughout the year, whether we get this grant or not, we need the new roof soon.
