A fun, science-based program designed just for pre-schoolers. Topics and activities vary each month

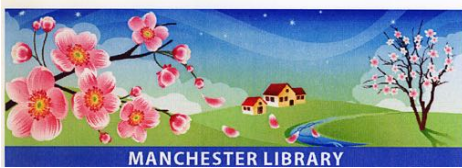
