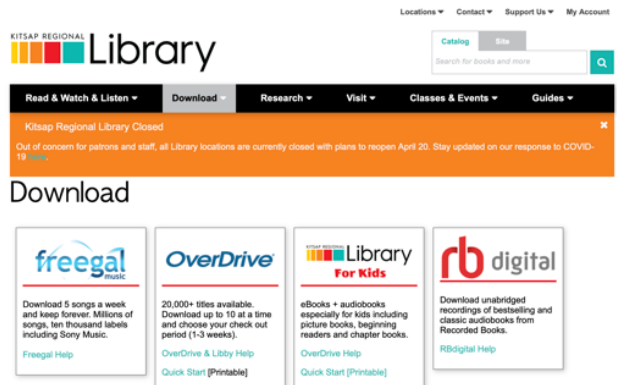

If you have a library card: On your computer, iPad or phone, Go to www.krl.org

And you will see the KRL screen, click on Download ... and the Screen *shown above* will appear. Follow the instructions, and they will help you download books. For example, I clicked on Overdrive, created an Overdrive account with my library card and password, selected Kindle (because I have Kindle readers on my iPad and computer), clicked on the “available” button (to avoid all the books that are checked-out) and found several thousand wonderful books. I selected one that I was interested in, and Overdrive took me to an Amazon.com page, where I signed in and selected the “Get Library Book” button on the Amazon.com page. When I signed onto the Kindle Reader on my iPad, the book was downloading. Note: there are great instructions on the Overdrive page for almost every device you can imagine.
