**Cal** by Bernard MacLaverty ... a novel of a young man's choices in Northern Ireland in 1980's

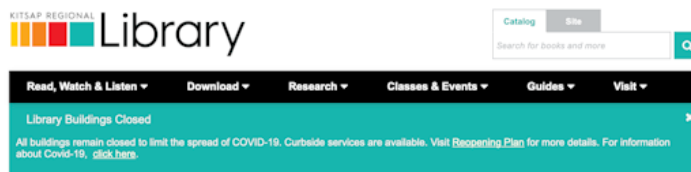
